The Collision Career Apprentice Pilot Program (“Program”) associated with Ranken Technical College (“we,” “our,” or “us”) provides this Privacy Policy (“Policy”) to describe how we collect, use, and disclose information through our website Beacollisionengineer.com (“Site”).

Information We Collect

When using our Site, you may voluntarily provide information about yourself, including your name, mailing address, email address, city and state, phone number and any other information you choose to provide. We collect this information when you use our Site, contact us through the Site, make requests regarding our Program or interact with us for any other purpose. We also gather demographic information, such as age, gender, preferences, interests, and favorites.

Our Site may include functions for sharing information about yourself publicly including social media sharing features, chat rooms, forums, message boards, and /or news groups. Choosing to share information about yourself publicly falls outside of this Policy.

We collect information relating to your interactions with us and our Site, including your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses and other information we collect through the use of cookies and similar technology. We use this information to operate and enhance our Site and Program. How We Use Your Information

We may use your information for any lawful purpose, including the following:

- To create and maintain your account;
- To communicate with you about the Program;
- To provide information on partner services and offerings including partner schools;
- To respond to your inquiries;
- To provide products and services you request, including to provide publications to which you subscribe;
- To operate, personalize, and improve the Site, including for analytics purposes;
- To analyze the outcomes and success of the Program;
- To send surveys, promotions, and marketing materials that may be of interest to you;
- For our other business purposes, such as research, lead generation, advertising, payment processing, data hygiene, and operational purposes;
- To comply with the law and to maintain the security of our Site; or
- With your consent, or as otherwise disclosed at the time information is collected.

Information Sharing

We may share the information we collect about you as described below:

- With our affiliate schools, vendors, consultants, agents, contractors, and other service providers that we use to support our business;

- To operate, maintain, and improve our Site;
- To fulfill your orders and requests;
- With other companies or schools to send you information about their products and services that may be relevant to you;
- As part of a corporate sale, merger, or acquisition, or other transfer of all or part of our assets, including as part of a bankruptcy proceeding;
- Pursuant to a subpoena, court order, governmental inquiry, or other legal process or as otherwise required by law, or to protect our rights or the rights of third parties;
- With your consent or as otherwise disclosed at the time of data collection or sharing.

We may share information that has been anonymized or aggregated without limitation.

Digital Advertising & Analytics
